

STUDENTS' FEEDBACK 2019-20

The students are the most important stakeholders of Higher Education systems. The interest and participation of students at all levels in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance play a central role. We have analyzed 77 students' feedback on the syllabus of the various programs (CBCS) designed by the University of Tumkur.

The analysis of the survey results reveals that the syllabus was covered excellently and very good by 31.17% and 32.47% of the respondents respectively. 23.38% of the respondents rated the coverage as good and 11.69% as satisfactory. Only 1.30% of the respondents rated the coverage as poor.

The organization of the course was excellent and very good to 49.35% and 31.17% of the respondents respectively. Only 6.49% of the respondents rated it as good, 9.09% as satisfactory and 3.90% as poor.

The emphasis on fundamentals was excellent and very good to 22.08% and 42.86% of the respondents respectively. 27.27% of the respondents rated it as good, 6.49% as satisfactory and 1.30% as poor.

The coverage of modern/ advanced topics was excellent and very good to 23.38% and 33.77% of the respondents respectively. 23.38% of the respondents rated it as good, 11.69% as satisfactory and 7.79% as poor.

The availability of textbooks and study materials is generally good, with 35.06% of respondents rating it as excellent, 35.06% rating it as very good, and 19.48% rating it as good.

The usefulness of tests and assignments, however, is more mixed, with 51.95% rating it as excellent, 25.97% rating it as very good, 6.49% rating it as good, and 7.79% rating it both satisfactory and poor.


The overall rating of the course is also mixed, with 33.77% rating it excellent, 32.47% rating it very good, 16.88% rating it good, and 14.29% rating it satisfactory. In contrast, only 2.60% of respondents rated the overall course rating as poor.

The survey results show that most students feel proud to be a part of SSCASC and they are highly satisfied with the learning experiences they had in the college. 
TEACHERS' FEEDBACK 2019-20


Overall, the feedback on curriculum, teaching, learning and evaluation was mostly positive with a majority of respondents strongly agreeing or agreeing. Specifically, respondents strongly agreed that syllabus is suitable to the course, course content is followed by corresponding reference materials, the course/syllabus has made me interested in the subject area, and the course/syllabus of this subject increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area. Additionally, respondents agreed that aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teacher and students, sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the library, the course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application, the books prescribed/listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and appropriate, tests and examinations are conducted well in time with proper coverage of all units in the syllabus, and the administration is teacher friendly.
