

Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is made on 15th July 2022

between

District Hospital, Tumkur

which is represented by its
District Surgeon, District Hospital Tumkur.

and

Sree Siddaganga College of Arts, Science & Commerce

which is represented by its
Principal, SSCASC, Tumkur.


The purpose of the agreement is to maintain physical and mental health of all staffs, students and educate society.

Now this MOU witness and it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. District Hospital, Tumkur will assist and support to conduct health camp by provide Medical Services like-Physicians for general check up's, Eye specialist for eye testing and Laboratory technicians for blood group detection for staff and students if further treatment is required they will be providing best possible treatment.
2. District Hospital will provide Psychiatrist to accomplish counseling session for the needy students and staff.
3. District Hospital will furnish Resource persons while organizing special lecture / talk / workshop for the students and staff if requested on health related topics.
4. District Hospital, Tumkur will initiate and support to conduct Awareness Program for students, staff and society.
5. District Hospital, Tumkur will share its resources like specialist, labs to educate our staffs if needed in future to enrich their knowledge in curriculums.
6. If college starts any related Certificate Courses in future, District Hospital, Tumkur will guide and provide few supports like subject experts, permission to visits labs occasionally for smooth conduct of the program.
7. District hospital will provide Medical certificate for the needy students like sports, NCC students based on their medical fitness.
8. Sree Siddaganga College of Arts, Science and Commerce will provide volunteers to District Hospital, Tumkur if there is any requirement.
9. Staff and Students will voluntarily donate blood in any medical emergencies.
10. Staff and students of Sree Siddaganga College of Arts, Science and Commerce will support and participate in Awareness Program conducted by District Hospital, Tumkur to educate society.

This MOU shall come into force with effect from 15th of JULY 2022 and will remain in force till five years i.e., 15th JULY 2027 and may be continued by approval of both parties by giving written notice. MOU can be terminated by either party by giving one month's prior notice.


