The Indian Red Cross Society was formed in 1920 by an act of Parliament. Hence, the President of India is the President of the Society and the Hon'ble Union Health and Family Welfare Minister its Vice-President. Governors of States are State Presidents.

The IRCS has 35 states/union territories branches with their more than 700 districts and sub districts branches.

The vice president is elected by the members of managing body

The National Managing body consists of 19 members. The Chairman and 6 members are nominated by president. The remaining 12 members are elected by the state and union territory branches through an electoral college

The Secretary General is the chief executive of the society

Youth Red Cross Symbol



The Red Cross symbolizes as an identifier for medical personnel during wartime. The Red Cross is defined as a protection symbol in Article 7 of the 1864 Geneva Convention, Chapter VII ("The distinctive emblem") and Article 38 of the 1949 Geneva Convention ("For the Amelioration of the Condition of the Wounded and Sick in Armed Forces in the Field"). There is an unofficial agreement within the Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement that the shape of the cross should be a cross composed of five squares. However, regardless of the shape, any Red Cross on white background should be valid and must be recognized as a protection symbol in conflict. Of the 190 National Societies which are currently recognized by the ICRC, 154 are using the Red Cross as their official organization emblem. The Red Cross, Red Crescent and red crystal are symbols of protection. The emblems are not religious symbols.

Fundamental Principles of Youth Red Cross

1. **HUMANITY:** The Red Cross, born of a desire to bring assistance without discrimination to the wounded on the battlefield, endeavors – in its international and national capacity – to prevent and alleviate human suffering wherever it may be found. Its purpose is to protect life and health and to ensure respect for the human being. It promotes mutual understanding, friendship, co-operation and lasting peace amongst all peoples.
2. **IMPARTIALITY:** It makes no discrimination as to nationality, race, religious beliefs, class or political opinions. It endeavors only to relieve suffering, giving priority to the most urgent cases of distress.
3. **NEUTRALITY:** In order to continue to enjoy the confidence of all, the Red Cross may not take sides in hostilities or engage at any time in controversies of a political, racial, religious or ideological nature.
4. **INDEPENDENCE:** The Red Cross is independent. The National Societies, while auxiliaries in the humanitarian services of their Governments and subject to the laws of their respective countries, must always maintain their autonomy so that they may be able at all times to act in accordance with Red Cross principles.
5. **VOLUNTARY SERVICE:** The Red Cross is a voluntary relief organization not prompted in any manner by desire for gain.
6. **UNITY:** There can be only one Red Cross Society in any one country. It must be open to all. It must carry on its humanitarian work throughout its territory.
7. **UNIVERSALITY:** The Red Cross is a world-wide institution in which all Societies have equal status and share equal responsibilities and duties in helping each other.


First Aid Kit distribution on -19-02-2023
